You will be assigned a Registration Time Ticket which you can access through the Student Information Web Service page (go to: www.capilanou.ca and click *MyCap* in the top right-hand corner). Once you have logged on to Student Web Services, open the Registration menu and select *Check Your Registration Status*.

The Tourism Management Program for International Students is a full-time program and students must follow the program profile and take all courses set out for them each term. Any deviation from the profile may result in a delayed graduation date. This program is not for part-time students.

Students who are <u>new</u> to Capilano University are required to submit a tuition deposit of \$5,000 within 7 days of the date of this letter. Once this deposit has been received, Capilano University will issue the letter required for your study permit application. Students can pay their deposit and/or tuition with cash, money order, credit card, bank draft, wire transfer, on-line banking, or debit card.

If, for some reason, you are unable to participate in the Tourism Management Program for International Students in September 2018, please notify our office **immediately**.

Please keep us up-to-date on your current mailing address and provide us with a <u>local Vancouver</u> <u>address</u> if you have not already done so.

Tuition fees are currently being reviewed by Capilano's administration, but you can expect tuition to be approximately \$10,000 for the Fall 2018 term. Please consult the Capilano University website for fee payment deadlines applicable to the Fall 2018 term, once they are available.
