Next steps:

1. **Pay your tuition, including the \$1,000.00 commitment fee, by July 25, 2018.**
For tuition fees and refund policy, visit [BMS: Costs and Supplies](#). The commitment fee is non-transferable and refundable only if your study permit is denied and you provide official supporting documentation from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC).
2. **[Medical insurance](#):** Medical insurance is **mandatory** during your studies at BCIT.
3. **Submit proof of your study permit to the ISC at least 7 days before your program starts.**
Contact your Admissions Officer if you cannot submit proof by the deadline.
4. A few weeks prior to program start, International Student Centre will email you the program orientation information. You will receive your class schedule at orientation.

BCIT tuition and associated fees are established and reviewed periodically by the BCIT Board of Governors. These fees are subject to change.

International students: The official acceptance letter required to obtain your study permit from Citizenship and Immigration Canada will be emailed to you once you have paid the commitment fee.

Please note: BCIT does not accept credit card payments for tuition or rent.

Please include your student ID number with payment. Allow three (3) business days processing time in order to meet your tuition deadline. Cheques and money orders should be payable to BCIT.
