# Re: Letter of Acceptance to the Bachelor of Hospitality Management Degree at Acsenda School of Management – Requirement for Internship

To Whom It May Concern,

The Bachelor of Hospitality Management (BHM) degree is a four year undergraduate degree program approved by the Minister of Advanced Education in BC under the Degree Authorization Act and the Degree Quality Assurance Board. The program commenced in April 2016. A 6-month paid internship is a required component of the Bachelor of Hospitality Management (BHM) degree that students must complete normally about two years into the program.

The primary purpose of the internship is to offer work experience and skill development in an enterprise enabling the student's theoretical knowledge to be augmented through practical career-related work experience and to prepare students for the world of work. Each student is required to complete a 6-month (6 credits) internship in order to graduate. The Internship (BGHL 440) is 6-credit course requiring a minimum of 6 consecutive months working in an approved hospitality business. In cases of prior industry experience of a minimum one-year, the student may write and submit an internship report and subject to approval, may receive a 3-month and 3 credits toward completion of BGHL 440.

The duration of the internship does not form more than 50% of the program. It is equivalent to two courses out of 39 courses required for the whole program (or 6 credits out of 123 credits for the BHM degree). Information on the exact start dates and employer placement will not be known until the student registers for BGHL 440. An estimated start date is provided above.

The Internship Coordinator, a BHM faculty member, provides guidance to students before and during the internship course but students are responsible for applying for and securing an appropriate internship placement. Internships are chosen based on their potential to provide as broad an experience as possible in relation to the academic content and skills to be developed in the BHM program. Unlike a practicum, in a career college, the students are not monitored by their instructor regarding the application of specific skills. While there are additional assignments to be submitted, the internship does not include in class instruction. The student is accountable to the employer for the performance of work assigned on the job. The student is accountable to Acsenda School of Management for successful completion of an internship and for the additional assignments required to reflect what learning occurred during the internship.

## **COURSE LEARNING OUTCOMES**

At the end of the course, the student should be able to:

- Demonstrate, through active participation, an understanding of the recruitment, screening, interview and hiring process.
  - Analyze the roles and functions of a leader and of a manager in the hospitality industry.
- Demonstrate, through participation and modelling, an understanding of the importance of outstanding guest service quality in the hospitality industry.
- Analyze and evaluate goal-setting, team-building, organizational culture in the workplace.
- Demonstrate an understanding and awareness of the cross-cultural, ethical and environmental issues in the management of hospitality organizations and their relationship with the local community and stakeholders.
- Analyze and evaluate your skills and learning outcomes during the internship.
- Demonstrate an understanding of a need for career planning.
