RESIDENCE APPLICATION PROCESS

Following the submission of the Lethbridge College Residence Intent Form:

- \$30 application fee will be processed and credit card information will be shredded
- Student status will be reviewed
 - Student must be a confirmed student at Lethbridge College and accepted into a program
 - If student is not a confirmed student, this form will be kept on file until confirmation is received from Admissions. Upon confirmation of student status, student will be placed on Residence Waitlist
- Student will be sent a link via email (Lethbridge College email preferred) to complete an online questionnaire
 - Online questionnaires must be completed in order to receive an Offer of Residence
- Based on availability, student will be sent a residence offer, or remain on the waitlist
- To be provided with, and confirm a residence offer, student must:
 - Pay a deposit of \$550 on or before the stated deadline date
 - Of the \$550 deposit, \$200 will be allocated as an incidental deposit and \$350 will be allocated as a damage deposit AND;
 - Complete the online contract
- Rent is payable per term and is non-refundable
 - Fall term rent due: August 1
 - Winter term rent due: December 1
 - If an offer is made within the month prior to the start of the term, rent is due upon confirmation
