Your next steps to becoming a student at VIU...

1. Apply for your Study Permit (and other government travel documents)

All international students studying in Canada in programs of 6 months or longer need to have a Study Permit. Use the attached Letter of Acceptance (LOA) to apply for your <u>study permit</u> from the nearest Canadian Embassy, Consulate or High Commission. In addition you will need either a Temporary Resident Visa or an Electronic Travel Authorization. <u>Click here</u> to learn which document is required for citizens from your country. If your program has an internship or work practicum, (see Box 24 on your LOA) you also must apply for a <u>co-op work permit</u> with the same application. Visit <u>VIU</u> immigration information or <u>Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada</u> for more information.

2. Begin your Pre-arrival "Course" and Sign up for Smooth Sailing; International Student Orientation (ISO)

Join **International Ready, Set, Go – Launchpad to Success at VIU** the online pre-arrival program for International Students at VIU. This program will help you learn what you need to do to prepare you for your arrival in Canada and to get ready for your studies at VIU. 3. Prepare your academic plan

Start to prepare for course registration (selection). Review the <u>web-registration tutorial</u> and learn how to enroll in courses. If you want further help, and are in Nanaimo already, you can attend one of the in-person <u>Course Selection</u> and <u>Registration sessions</u>. If you wish to consult an Advisor from afar, please email <u>advising.international@viu.ca</u>. **Important:** Watch your email for more information about your registration date and time! Registration for Fall and Spring semesters begins in **May**. (Note: For certain programs such as Hospitality, Tourism, Design and others, you may notice that you have already been assigned courses prior to semester start up. Please don't drop your enrollment from these classes!)

4. Explore your housing options

Now is the time to think about where you want to live. Apply early if you wish to live in residence <u>on campus</u> (before May 1 for Fall Semester) or in the community in a <u>homestay</u> arrangement (at least 2-3 months in advance of your program start). 5. Send your official/original documents

All students coming to VIU must supply us with official academic documents and transcripts – which become property of the university and **will not be returned**. If you have not already done so, please send your official final high school and post-secondary transcripts to: International Admissions, Vancouver Island University, 900 Fifth Street, Nanaimo BC Canada V9R 5S5

6. Apply for Transfer Credit

If you have academic credits from a previous post-secondary program or International Baccalaureate (IB) program you <u>may</u> be able to transfer credits to VIU. If you would like recognition/credit for in your undergraduate program at VIU, apply for <u>transfer credit</u> by completing the online form and by providing course outlines and original documents to international admissions. 7. Learn about Medical/ Health Insurance Coverage at VIU
