1 Bedroom apartment	\$1,200 - \$1,400 CND / month	
2 Bedroom apartment	\$1,400 - \$2,200 CDN/ month for the entire place	
Shared room in private student residence	\$1,300 - \$1,500 CDN / month	

Food and eating out		
Groceries	\$100 CDN / week	Varies by personal needs.
Eating out / Delivery	\$40 - \$100 CDN /month	Varies by personal needs. You may want to cook at home to save money
Coffee shops	\$40 - \$100 CDN / month	Varies by personal needs. Consider investing in a kettle or coffee machine, as well as in a travel mug.

Books and supplies	\$500 - \$3000 CDN / duration of program	Depends on professor and their required textbooks

Internet	\$30 - \$100 CDN / month (depending on plan, speed, and type of service) + \$50 CDN one-time installation fee	If you are renting a shared room, your rent might already include the cost of internet.
Metro Pass	\$120 CDN / month – or \$3.25 for a single ride	If you are planning on living close to campus, a bike might be a good idea for the Spring, Summer, and beginning of Fall.
Health Insurance - MANDATORY	\$600 - \$800 CDN / year (depending on plan selected)	You must have health insurance prior to starting your classes. You can buy your plan by visiting www.inglestudents.com/yorkvilleu

Monthly and depending on your life style, you are looking into spending between \$1,000 and \$1,500+ CDN per month.
