- d. Are there any instructions/deadlines that you have to follow?

#### 2. Apply for a Study Permit, Biometrics, Temporary Resident Visa (TRV), and Co-Op Work Permit

*Please be aware that not all students will require a Co-Op Work Permit or TRV or Biometrics;*

  - i. Students are advised to apply for their study permit 2 – 3 months before they are to depart for Canada however for some countries you will want to apply sooner;
- g. If working with an agent be sure that you get copies of your application and check the information for accuracy before submitted to the Canadian Embassy;
- h. If under the age of 18, bring a copy of the custodian form that your parents had to complete for your study permit application.
