- 2. Medical insurance: Medical insurance ismandatoryduring your studies at BCIT.
- 3. Submit proof of your study permit to the ISC at least 7 days before your program starts. Contact your Admissions Officer if you cannot submit proof by the deadline.

A few weeks prior to program start, International Student Centre will email you the program orientation information. You will receive your class schedule at orientation.

BCIT tuition and associated fees are established and reviewed periodically by the BCIT Board of Governors and are subject to change.

The official acceptance letter required to obtain your study permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) will be emailed to you once you have paid the commitment fee.
