Students may be charged a \$150.00 late payment fee for any payment received after the due dates.

All International Student withdrawal requests are handled in person through the International Office. Be advised that any refunds that are authorized will be less the application fee, tuition and ancillary fee as per MTCU Policy, and other fees as outlined in our withdrawal and refund policy. Study Permits are issued based on letters of admission to Durham College, so International Students are expected to attend this college.
