Medical Insurance

Medical Insurance is mandatory for the duration of your studies at BCIT. You are legally required to apply for the British Columbia Medical Services Plan (MSP) when you arrive in BC. Please note there is a 2-3 month <u>waiting period</u> before new arrivals to BC are eligible for MSP coverage. To cover you during your MSP waiting period, you will be charged a \$180, non-refundable fee and enrolled for 3 months of temporary private medical insurance.

You may be eligible to opt out by showing proof of adequate medical coverage at least 90 days before your program start date. Visit <u>Medical Insurance for Full-Time Students</u> page for more information on coverage dates, how to opt out or how to apply for MSP.

Housing

<u>Student Housing</u> provides on-campus housing at Maquinna Residence and support in finding off-campus housing. The residence application deadline is June 1st for programs starting in September. Accommodation is limited and not guaranteed.
