Frequently Asked Questions

How do I accept an offer letter?

Applicants who are provided an offer of admission are required to accept their offer by paying a non-refundable* confirmation deposit. **The deposit is only refundable if the applicant's study permit is denied by IRCC. Proof of denial must be presented to request a refund.*

All Offer Letters will have an expiration date informing until when the offer is still valid. Also, all offers of admission must be accepted before Deadline to pay confirmation deposit.

Note: any offers not accepted by the deadline will expire and be rescinded.

How can I submit my documents to satisfy the conditions?

High School Transcript: For schools overseas, KPU requires official transcripts in a sealed envelope to be mailed directly by the student and/or institution. Notarized copies are not accepted (unless results can be verified online). Canadian schools are required to send the documents directly to KPU. Starting from the September 2019 intake, all international students are required to provide proof of a valid post-secondary study permit by the Deadline to provide proof of study permit.

Students that fail to provide such documentation on time will be dropped from classes and the seat offer will be revoked. You can submit a copy of your study permit using the iCent app, emailing international@kpu.ca or bring in a copy in person at our International front desk in the Richmond or Surrey campus.

How much does tuition cost?

Effective Fall 2018, the cost per credit is \$658.03/credit for new or readmitted international students. Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU) requires international students holding a valid study permit to take a minimum of 9 credits per semester in order to maintain their fulltime student status. Please note that while most courses are 3 credits, some courses may vary.

Can I take courses at KPU while completing my English upgrading?

Yes – that's the great thing about the Pathway to Undergraduate Studies! As a student in the Pathway Program, you can complete your upgrading through our Faculty of Academic and Career Advancement (ACA) while taking certain undergraduate courses made available through our other Faculties. For example, if you've been admitted to the School of Business, you can begin pursuing your Business courses at the same time as you complete your English upgrading. Can an applicant re-submit an English proficiency Testing during the time of application?

NO: If an applicant has already been admitted i.e has accepted the offer by paying the international confirmation deposit. They are unable to submit a new IELTS, to skip pathway levels and meet our direct undergraduate requirements.

YES: If an applicant has not yet accepted the offer, and submits a new English proficiency testing results during the application stage.

What if I want to change my program?

KPU applicants may request a change to their application for the current term by completing the Change to Application for Admission form. Acceptable changes include:

- » Changing from a limited intake program to a different limited intake program or to an open intake program (within stated application deadlines)
- » Changing to an open intake from one Faculty to another Faculty

Applicants requesting a change of application to an alternate term have the option to either:

- » Request a deferral of admission and deposit (if they have been admitted to an open intake), or
- » Re-apply online to the alternate term

The following deadlines apply:

- » Limited Intake programs: Submit this form at least 6 months prior to start of term requested.
- » Open Intake programs: Submit this form at least 3 months prior to start of term requested.
