PAYMENT OPTIONS FROM OUTSIDE OF CANADA:

1) Sault College uses CIBC International Student Pay for all international payments made from accounts outside of Canada. Please use the CIBC International Student Pay secure online platform at <https://pay.cibc.com/sault>. You will receive a quote in your local currency and can choose from the following payment options: Bank wire; Visa and MasterCard, China UnionPay, or ACH Direct Debit. Receipts will be loaded to the application portal as soon as they are available.

- You can complete an online transfer from your bank account by setting the college up as a payee/bill payment and using the student number as the account number
