Congratulations, you have been accepted into the Graduate Certificate in Project Management program at Algoma University's Brampton Campus starting September 9, 2020.

Your total tuition (for four semesters), excluding student ancillary fees, student insurance and health plans, for the Graduate Certificate in Project Management program is \$30,575 (\$36,575 tuition reduced by a \$6,000 bursary total or \$1,500 per semester). Note, third and fourth semester tuition is subject to a standard tuition rate increase. To guarantee your spot in this program a \$16,000 non-refundable deposit for the first and second semester tuition fee is required by July 17, 2020. The balance of tuition fees are due in full by March 19, 2021. Please note this is a limited enrolment program, therefore, we encourage you to submit your deposit as soon as possible to ensure your registration in the program.

All student ancillary fees, student insurance and health plan fees are assessed each semester. These fees are due in full before the start of the applicable semester.

This Letter of Acceptance constitutes your confirmation into the Graduate Certificate in Project Management program and can be used to apply for your study permit at the Canadian High Commission/Canadian Embassy in your country. This Letter of Acceptance is only valid to apply for a study permit if accompanied by the deposit receipt. As it can often take several weeks to process your study permit, please apply as soon as possible (www.cic.gc.ca).

Refunds will **only** be issued to students who provide written proof from the Canadian High Commission/Canadian Embassy that their study permit was denied and they have not registered in any online courses with the University. The written proof must be submitted to Algoma University within three months of the date of the refusal letter from the Canadian High Commission/Canadian Embassy.

Important Information

Payment

The Letter of Acceptance is only valid to apply for a Study Permit (visa) when accompanied by a non-refundable Semester One deposit receipt, confirming the prepayment of the required fees. Your required deposit is indicated in your Letter of Acceptance. Failure to pay the Semester One deposit by the deadline, will result in the rescinding or deferral of your offer. Failure to pay the Semester Two deposit by the deadline will result in deregistration of courses and deem you ineligible to register for future courses.

Failure to make payment is a violation of the terms and conditions of the Algoma University Academic Calendar. Algoma University reserves the right to deregister students from courses for non-payment. In the event of deregistration, the student will remain financially responsible for all tuition and related fees. Non-payment of fees will also result in prohibited registration for future courses, inability to obtain statements of academic standing, transcript requests or other matters relating to academic progress until all outstanding fees have been paid in full.

Refund Process

Initial deposit - visa refusals

Refunds of the initial non-refundable deposit (less \$300 processing fee) will only be issued to international students who have been refused their study permit and have not registered for any online courses within an Algoma University program. A copy of the refusal letter issued by Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) must be provided to Algoma University, within three months of the date of the refusal letter. Students who have registered for online classes are not eligible for the refund. Processing times for these refunds can take up to 12 weeks from the date Algoma University receives all information required to process the refund.

Remaining fees

The amount of any refund (less \$1,000 non-refundable per semester, \$300.00 processing fee or reduction in any outstanding fees) will be calculated according to the deadline date by which the withdrawal form has been received by the Office of the Registrar.

No refunds are given for withdrawals after the last date to withdraw from courses as per the Academic Calendar.

Refund notes:

1. Students who withdraw on or before the first day of classes are eligible for a refund as per the refund policy. Ancillary fees are non-refundable after the first day of class.
2. After the first day of classes, remaining tuition fees are refunded based on the percentages noted in the refund schedule table in the current Academic Calendar.
3. After the fourth week of each term, tuition is non-refundable.
