
- *May 4, 2021: Online Orientation Session Begins*

- *If the COVID-19 Pandemic is still in effect, students coming to Canada will be required to self-isolate for 14-days. Please allow sufficient time to travel and to complete this self-isolation period.*

International students enrolled at Crandall University may be able to work off-campus for up to 20 hours per week. To be able to work in Canada, however, you must be registered and enrolled at Crandall, and you must apply and receive a **Social Insurance Number** from **Service Canada**.
