Congratulations! I am pleased to advise you of your **CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE** to the first year of the **POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN CULINARY MANAGEMENT** program at Selkirk College. Mandatory orientation classes begin on Thursday, April 29th, 2021. All students are required to be on campus by this date. Program specific orientation and classes begin on Monday, May 3rd, 2021.

Before full, unconditional admission can be offered, you must meet the following conditions:

- Payment of your tuition and fees
- Submission of notarized documents

Selkirk College accepts scanned, notarized copies of transcripts and other documents, **but you must bring the original documents with you for verification.**

The amount owing for your first year tuition and fees is as follows:

Program Tuition:	\$12,760.00
College Fees:	\$687.46
Kitchen Supplies:	\$600.00
Uniform, Knives, and Course Materials:	\$550.00
Basic Medical Insurance:	\$205.00
Total:	\$14,802.46

In addition, you will be required to pay the following fees once you have arrived at Selkirk College:

Extended Health and Dental \$279.00

Textbooks for one year \$200.00 (this is an estimate – some books can be bought used)

You are not required to pay this before you arrive, but please plan for this additional cost.

Students in the Post Graduate in Culinary Management program study their first and second years on the Tenth Street campus in Nelson, BC. Please note that the Post Graduate Culinary Management program does require completion of a 500-hour paid practicum in order to graduate. The cost of this practicum is currently \$549.09. This will be due before you start your practicum.

See attached bank transfer information for wire transfer of the **\$14,802.46**, which includes your non-refundable tuition deposit. See attached Tuition Fee Guidelines and Refund Policy for more information. Once your payment has been processed by the Finance department, and all other conditions for program admission are met, you will be issued a payment receipt and sent the full admission/offer letter, which you can use to apply for your Canadian study permit. **Note - We wish to inform you that we anticipate a 5% increase to tuition and fees for the second year of your program at Selkirk College.**

You will not be offered a seat in this program until all conditions are met. Seats in the Post Graduate Diploma in Culinary Management are limited, and are filled on a first come, first served basis. Should all seats in this program be filled before all conditions listed are met, you will automatically be placed on the waitlist.

Please inform us immediately once you have received your study permit. This information will help us to pre-register you into the courses you will need to take for your first semester. Failure to inform us in advance of your study permit approval may result in conflicting schedules and difficulties getting the right courses.
