

**TUITION AND FEES:** Updated Cape Breton University (CBU) tuition and fees can be found on our website at: [www.cbu.ca/tuition](http://www.cbu.ca/tuition). Tuition and fees are subject to change without notice. Please note that these numbers are an estimate based on the 2020-2021 tuition and fees.

**PRE-PAYMENT:** All payments will be credited directly to the student's account at CBU and the funds will be applied to their tuition and fees as incurred.

**REFUND POLICY:** CBU has recently updated its refund policy and it must be noted:

- CBU fully accepted students with a valid study permit who withdraw from CBU will not receive a refund of any pre-paid tuition or fees. Pre-paid tuition and fees are 100% non-refundable and will be withheld/forfeited to CBU.

\*\*Permanent Residents of Canada: Students registering as Permanent Residents of Canada will be charged International Differential Fees unless documentation verification has been provided to Cape Breton University. International Differential fees are mandatory for all international students.

\*\*\*Our international medical and dental plan is mandatory for all students. Dependent and family coverage options are available upon request.

- **Watch for your CBU Email information** - you will receive an email from IT Services at CBU outlining your new CBU email information. As soon as you receive your CBU email information, it is very important that you log in and check this email frequently. All future communication from CBU will be sent to your CBU email address and not to the email that you used to apply.
- **Log into your COMPASS Account** - browse your [student portal](#) to become familiar with the self-serve options and other features that will help you during your time at CBU. Check out our [How-To CBU YouTube series](#) for helpful videos.
- **Download your proof of payment** - your proof of payment will be available for download through your portal within 3-5 days of made. Remember to watch our [YouTube series](#) for helpful videos.
- **Academic Advising is Mandatory for all new students** – students must be advised prior to being able to register for courses. Staff at the First Year Advising Centre are available to help you select your courses and learn about services and other supports available to you as a CBU student. - **Register for courses** - once you've been advised, you can register for your courses.
