Congratulations on your offer of admission into the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) (General Degree) program, October 2021 term at Yorkville University, British Columbia campus.

The payment deadline for your fee deposit is 20 days from receipt of this letter. Students who submit a deposit within 20 days from the receipt of this preliminary letter of admission secure a seat in the program. If you fail to pay a deposit within 20 days of the receipt of this letter, you may be asked to re-apply or be placed on a waitlist without a guarantee of enrolment.

All students applying to Yorkville University are required to pay their fee deposit through the ApplyBoard payment portal. Please make your payment by clicking here.

By paying your fee deposit through the ApplyBoard Payment Portal, you are eligible for a \$10,000 bursary, which will be applied to your tuition account in the following manner. The bursary values assume you will study 12 credits (4 courses) a term and will complete 36 credits (12 courses) in your first three terms. In the event that a full 4 course term is not studied each of the first three terms, there will be a true-up in the final term of study to ensure that the student receives a full \$10,000 bursary over 120 credits.

Please review the following page for the sample tuition schedule for students receiving a \$10,000 bursary. Students with transfer credits will receive a prorated bursary amount distributed across their remaining courses. Your total first year fee deposit is \$15,000.

By paying your fee deposit through the ApplyBoard Payment Portal (either directly by yourself, or by a third party such as an education agent), you accept and agree to ApplyBoard's terms and conditions:

- An ApplyBoard Service Fee will be applied when you pay through the portal. The total amount of fee withheld by ApplyBoard as the ApplyBoard Service Fee for the BBA program is \$5,000.
- This service fee is non-refundable but will be applied to the student's third term fees upon successful completion of the first eight weeks of that term.
- Students who receive a study permit and withdraw before Thursday of week eight of their third term of study at Yorkville University will forfeit the \$500
 Yorkville University administrative fee and ApplyBoard Service Fee (as listed above).
- Students who are unsuccessful in obtaining a study permit are refunded their entire fee deposit payment less Yorkville University's \$500 administrative fee.
 Proof of a study permit refusal is required before this refund will be issued. Study permit refusal documents may be verified with Canadian authorities before the processing of refunds.

When you submit your fee deposit, you will receive a receipt and official acceptance letter. These documents are required as part of your study visa application to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). Yorkville University will contact you in advance of your start date and will provide a link to your New Student Registration Form as well as your Plan of Study. All international students who study on campus are required to enroll in a health insurance plan through Yorkville University.

At Yorkville University, we are working hard to accommodate those students whose education plans have been affected by COVID-19. We want to make it possible for you to begin your studies and graduate without interruption. To that end, Yorkville University's Head Start Program allows students to start their program online, from their home, in October 2021. For students who are committed to coming to Canada and want to begin their BBA from home, the Head Start Program reduces your risk of financial loss if you are refused a study permit.
