You will also be required to submit proof of payments to VCC. If you pay VCC by <u>Flywire</u>, you can print your payment receipt right away from the Flywire dashboard. If you pay VCC using another method, VCC will email you your payment receipt when the payment has been processed. Students who have a required co-op should upload this letter again in the co-op work letter section of the online application.
