Documents **Letter of Acceptance:** This letter must be included in your study permit application submitted to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) as a proof of your acceptance.

Receipt for tuition deposit and payments: If you would like a receipt to support your study permit application, go to [Self-Service](#) and select **Student Finance** and then *Account Activity*. Then choose either *Statement* (to view your account by term) or *Payments* to obtain receipts of individual payments.

Important Dates Mark the following dates on your calendar and contact us *prior* to the refund deadlines if your study permit application is still in progress or you are unable to attend.

Aug 1	Deposit refund deadline (If you withdraw after Aug 1, 100% of your deposit will be forfeited)
Sept 13	Full Tuition refund deadline – Up to this day, if you withdraw, you will receive a 100% refund of Fall tuition (minus the \$1000 deposit, if you withdrew after Aug 1)
Sept 14-26	Partial tuition refund deadline – If you withdraw in this period, you will receive a tuition refund minus a late-fee per course (and minus the \$1000 deposit)
After Sept 26-	No refund of Fall tuition

Planning Travel & Accommodations Once you receive notice that your study permit application has been approved, plan to travel to Canada no more than **4-6 weeks prior** to the start date of your program, as recommended by IRCC. You may be denied entry if you try to enter prior to this because your travel would be deemed non-essential.
