Study Permit

Make arrangements to apply for your study permit as soon as possible. Visa processing times vary from one country to another. You need to apply for your visa early enough to have it in hand before classes begin. Once your study permit has been approved, send us a copy so we can add it to your record. Visit the Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) website for details. You can apply online and only need the electronic copy of your acceptance letter.

If your program has a co-op work term, practicum, clinical or other form of work-integrated-learning, you need to apply for a co-op work permit. You can determine if you need a co-op work permit by checking page three, Box 24 on your acceptance letter on http://my.saskpolytech.ca/. If there is a number in that box, you need a co-op work permit. Please note that you can apply for your co-op work permit at the same time you apply for your study permit. Health Coverage

Upon arrival in Saskatchewan and has been enrolled, international students are eligible to apply for a Saskatchewan Health Card to receive medical coverage at no charge. Students must register themselves, including their dependents (if applicable). International students may also be eligible for the Saskatchewan Polytechnic Students' Association Health and Dental plan.

We strongly advise students to obtain short-term travel insurance to cover them until they have settled in Saskatchewan and receive their provincial health benefits.
