We are pleased to inform you that you have been granted acceptance to the **Electromechanical Engineering Technician - Co-op Option** program at Algonquin College! This program begins on September 05, 2023.

Condition of Acceptance (if applicable):

Students that currently hold a valid status in Canada are required to pay the \$1,500.00 CAD non-refundable tuition deposit to receive the **Letter of Acceptance**. The Letter of Acceptance can then be used to apply for or extend your post-secondary study permit.

Your payment must be received by August 25, 2023.

If payment is not received by this date, your acceptance will be withdrawn.

It is very important that you notify us through your online application portal once you have made your payment so we can prepare your Letter of Acceptance.

If you wish to pay the full first term fees, the estimated amount is **\$10,400.00 CAD**.

Please note that the payment must **be deposited in your student account by the deadline, not in transit**.

Bank payments, and in-Canada bill payments, can take 3 to 4 days to reach your account with us.

Important Information on the non-refundable Tuition Deposit:

- The tuition deposit will defer your remaining balance of your first term tuition fees. The remaining balance will be due three weeks after the start of your term.
- By paying the non-refundable tuition deposit you are confirming your acceptance and registration to the program. You will be responsible for payment of the remaining term fees unless you [officially withdraw](#) from Algonquin College before the term [refund](#) date.

Important Information on Withdrawals and Refunds:

- Please be aware of the Algonquin College [Withdrawal Policy](#) and [Refund Policy](#).
- Failing to show up for class does not constitute a withdrawal. Students who do not officially withdraw after acceptance are still liable to pay the remaining term balance.

3. Use your Letter of Acceptance to extend or apply for your post-secondary study permit
