4. Apply for a Canadian Study Permit

You should apply for a Canadian Study Permit from the Government of Canada as soon as possible.

Upload a copy of your Visa Approval to the International Application Portal no later than 60 days before the first day of class, or you could lose your seat in the program and be deferred to a later term.

- 5. Log into the <u>URSLC</u> platform using your SLC email address and complete the Mandatory International Student To-Do List, found under My Checklists
- 6. Present your Letter of Acceptance package to Canadian Border Services upon your first entry to Canada Arrive on campus before the International Orientation date.
