OTHER EXPENSES TO BE CONSIDERED

Please see below an estimated of extra expenses that are required when studying in Canada. These are an average estimation of costs and they are intended to be used as a guideline for planning your student journey while studying with Multihexa College.

Other expenses

Books and supplies	\$100 - \$800 CAD / duration of program
Utilities (Hydro (electricity) and Water)	\$35 - \$55 CAD / month (depending on usage)
Cell phone	\$50 CAD / month – depending on the plan
Internet	\$30 - \$90 CAD / month (depending on plan, speed, and type of service) + \$50 CAD one-time installation fee
Metro Pass (Public Transit)	\$120 CAD / month – or \$3.35 for a single fair
Health Insurance	\$3,00 per day (contact us for more information)

Housing in Toronto

Room in shared house	\$600 - \$900 CAD / month
Bachelor/Studio apartment	\$900 - \$1,200 CAD / month
1/2 Bedroom apartment	\$1,200 - \$2.300 CAD/ month
Shared room in private student residence	\$1,100 - \$1,800 CAD / month

**Note: To rent an apartment under your name, you must show proof of income and sign a 1-year lease.*

Food

Groceries	\$100 - \$120 CAD / week
Eating out / Delivery	\$40 - \$100 CAD /month
Coffee shops	\$40 - \$100 CAD / month

**Note: It varies by personal choices/needs.*
