7. Withdrawals and Refund Policy

Students must notify Sheridan at CCTT of all withdrawals prior to the 10th day of class by completing the International New Student Deferral/Refund Form. All fees are subject to a nonrefundable registration charge. This charge varies by program in the range of CAD \$1,038-\$3,800.

International students who are refused their study permit will receive a full refund of fees paid minus a \$200 administration fee provided they show proof of the refusal (copy of Immigration document) within the first 10 days of classes. The Health Insurance fee is Non-Refundable after the first day of class. All other refundable fees will be refunded. Please allow eight weeks for processing a refund.
