

Congratulations on your acceptance! You are one step closer to becoming a Crandall student. However, please be aware that as we get closer to the beginning of your program, you will need to take some important steps.

Checklist:

- 1** Receive and review your acceptance package, including your **Letter of Acceptance** and **Finance Estimate**.
- 2** Review the steps required to apply for your **study permit** at www.CIC.gc.ca and begin the process.
- 3** Get your finances in order and make a **tuition deposit** through www.PayMyTuition.com.
- 4** Submit your [study permit](#) application to the Government of Canada.
- 5** Send a copy of your **passport stamp** or **invitation to study letter** to International@CrandallU.ca showing your eligibility to study at Crandall as soon as you receive it.
- 6** **Enroll in your program.** Enrollment typically opens one month before your program begins, and you will receive an email regarding this process from our Registrar's Office.*
- 7** Attend a **pre-orientation webinar** hosted post-enrollment with our Admissions department, Academic department, and Student Life team. Check the email you applied with for an invite!

** This is the final step to securing your seat. Once you have enrolled in your program and received confirmation from our Registrar, your seat is confirmed, and you will be able to join us at Crandall.*

- Students whom the Registrar does not confirm for enrollment may be deferred to another semester. As spaces are limited, students who receive their permit once the program is full will be placed on a waitlist and given priority placement for the next available semester.
- Please do not book travel to Canada until you are fully registered and confirmed by the Registrar's Office in your program.
- The application process for a study permit may take 3-4 months and sometimes longer. Therefore, please ensure you apply as soon as possible to avoid delays.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR PAYMENT

Paying tuition with PayMyTuition is safe, fast, and convenient. Follow the simple steps below to complete your payment:

ENTER YOUR INSTITUTION NAME

Go to paymytuition.com. From the drop-down menu, select your institution, then enter your payment amount and the country you are paying from.

SELECT PAYMENT METHOD

Review the payment options provided and select your preferred payment method. Payment options include bank transfers, debit/credit cards in your home currency, electronic and eWallet payments and other local options.

ENTER YOUR DETAILS

Create your account and enter some basic information including your student number if you have it. If you do not have a Crandall student number yet, please enter your birthday as your student number.

(Example May 1, 1995 = 050195) We will include this information to your payment for easy identification of your payment by your institution.

MAKE YOUR PAYMENT

Follow the instructions provided to send your funds to **PayMyTuition by MTFX** via your selected payment method.
