The Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)

As of January 22, 2024, 8:30 a.m. EST., a Provincial Attestation Letter is a mandatory component of all new study permit applications as per <u>IRCC Guidelines</u>. To request a Provincial Attestation Letter for you, the following pre-requisites must be satisfied:

- The full tuition fees for the first semester must be paid.
- · You are accepted to a program and have an active offer.

If you meet the eligibility criteria established by Conestoga College, you will receive communication containing additional instructions on how to proceed with requesting your Provincial Attestation Letter. **Please note that a non-refundable deposit of \$2500 will apply upon withdrawal after confirming your admission.**

Cost of Living
