Study Permit Approval

To confirm your seat, you must submit proof of your valid study permit approval to ieadmissions@vcc.ca by **November 15, 2024**. You may submit a copy of your Canadian Study Permit, a copy of your IRCC Port of Entry (POE) letter, or proof of Study Permit extension submission confirmation prior to the original study permit end date. Failure to submit proof of approval by this date may result in your seat being offered to another student. If your Study Permit is in process or not approved by this date, you may be deferred to the next available intake. If you have already submitted your Study Permit approval to us, thank you - you do not need to re-submit to us.

Official Original Educational Documents

You must bring all official original educational documents used for admission to VCC with you to Canada. VCC reserves the right to request your educational documents at any time for review.

Fees, Payments, and Fee Increases
