Due December 16, 2024: Submit missing required document(s), Official Transcript (s) in sealed envelope(s), copy of study permit, and copy of proof of medical insurance.

- Adhere to the requirements mentioned below:

To ensure that students graduate with real-world knowledge and a strong understanding of leadership and management practices within a given field, CityU's program includes a mandatory internship* for all MEd in Leadership students. Each student is required to complete 3 mandatory internship courses, each inclusive of sections A and B, linked to a total of 8 credits, to graduate.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR DEPOSIT PAYMENT.

The payment of your deposit confirms that you agree to be bound by the below conditions.

The initial deposit specified on page 1 of this offer letter includes a **\$9,020.00 CAD NON-REFUNDABLE** tuition deposit for your study at CityU, subject to the conditions and exceptions listed below:

- i. Full refund (less a \$200 application fee and \$300 administrative fees) will be granted if Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) does not approve a student Study Permit. To obtain a refund, student must submit refund request along with the visa refusal letter from IRCC to [intl admissionscanada@cityu.edu](mailto:intladmissionscanada@cityu.edu) within 30 days of the issuance of the visa refusal letter.
- ii. No refund will be granted to a student denied Study Permit due to fraudulent documents.
- iii. Students who withdraw due to exceptional circumstances may submit a petition for a refund. CityU retains the right to determine what an exceptional circumstance is and what documentation is required to prove the exceptional circumstances occurred.
- iv. Students who receive a study permit will follow the [International Student Refund Policy](#) listed on our website.
- v. The non-refundable tuition deposit is non-transferable and applies throughout the duration of the program.
- vi. Deferral Policy: If a student is unable to start the semester due to a delay in receiving a Study Permit or an exceptional circumstance, a student may apply to defer to a further intake on a one-time only basis, excluding situation outlined in section ii. Subsequent requests for a deferral may incur a deferral charge.
