- 1. Activate your IT account and accept your offer of admission in Student Self-Service. Step 1 provides direction on finalizing both of these important details!
- 2. Confirm your acceptance by paying your confirmation deposit. See Step 2 for important deadlines and instructions. Remember your seat is not finalized until the fee is paid!
- 3. Make sure you review Steps 3-13 for important details on program information, college policies, finances, technology, transfer credit assessment, accessibility and more!
- 4. Visit our website for information on the updated international application process including details on the Provincial Attestation (PAL) process.

REGISTER ONLINE: All students are required to register at the beginning of their program. Students will receive an email 4-6 weeks prior to term start indicating their time to register. Be sure that NBCC has your most current email address on file. For more information visit our <u>Online Registration</u> webpage.

STUDY PERMIT: Now that you have been accepted to NBCC, you will need to apply for a study permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). We strongly advise you to start gathering the requirements *immediately* as this can be a lengthy process. Information on how to apply for a study permit/visa can be found at www.canada.ca >Immigration > Study.

- This letter of acceptance and attached student information form is a mandatory component to your study
 permit application. You will need to upload the entire PDF document as your letter of acceptance, including
 the emailed receipt (issued within 3-5 business days) that you will receive after paying your non-refundable
 confirmation deposit.
- As part of the recent Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) changes, most initial study
 permit applications for studies at NBCC will require a provincial attestation letter (PAL) from the province of
 New Brunswick. For details on NBCC's requirements for a provincial attestation letter (PAL) visit our website
 . It is critical to review that information carefully as there are deadlines and criteria that you must meet to
 receive a provincial attestation letter (PAL).
