You are strongly encouraged to join our Study Permit Preparation Webinar, where our team of Regulated Canadian Immigration Consultants (RCICs) will explain the study permit application process and outline the required documentation. You will receive a separate email with registration details for the webinar.

Fee Deposit and Required Documents:

Upon receipt of fee deposit, eligible students will receive both a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) and Letter of Acceptance (LOA). These documents are required as part of your study permit application to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). Please note that not every student will be eligible for a PAL on an intake to intake basis.

Further Steps:

Yorkville University will contact you before your start date and will provide a link to your New Student Registration Form and your Plan of Study. Please note that students must register for courses before the start of the program. Additionally, all international students will be automatically enrolled in a mandatory health insurance plan through Yorkville University.

- 1. An academic year consists of 9 months (3 terms). Yorkville University programs offer 4 terms in a calendar year.
- 2. Fees are estimated at the 2024-2025 rate. Fees may be increased annually. Annual increases are scheduled for the October start date and typically fall between 4-6%. Changes to tuition rates will be announced at least 3 months prior to the start of the term to which they apply. Current tuition rates are available on the University's website. The costs mentioned above do not include other fees such as books, expendable supplies, health insurance or cost of living. If program fee or bursary changes are made prior to the start of the program, an incremental charge to the student may occur.
- This bursary is automatically applied to any courses where the student pays full tuition and international fees. Students with transfer credits will receive a prorated bursary amount distributed across their remaining courses. The organization reserves the right to change how and when the bursary is distributed over the duration of the program. Bursaries will only be applied to outstanding tuition, and no excess funds will be disbursed or refunded.
- 4. Failure to submit a deposit within 20 days of receiving this letter may result in students being required to reapply or being placed on a waitlist with no assurance of enrolment.
- Students paying the fee deposit from a Canadian financial institution should contact ApplyBoard directly for instructions on how to submit their payment.
- 6. Students should pay the remainder of the first-term fee balance or have a payment plan in place prior to the commencement of their program. Students are encouraged, where possible, to pay a deposit equal to a full year's tuition. Please contact your International Admissions Advisor for details.

Refund Policy

By paying your fee deposit through the ApplyBoard Payment Portal (either directly by yourself or by a third party such as an education agent), you accept and agree to ApplyBoard's terms and conditions:

- All amounts paid by you to the school will be applied towards your tuition and other applicable fees once you have started your studies. Please note that your fee deposit is non-refundable, unless you are refused a study visa or provide IRCC proof of visa cancellation, in which case all but \$500 is refundable. Fees that are refundable will be returned to the source from which they originated.
- For refund request due to a visa refusal, please ensure that you apply for a refund and submit all required documents within 60 <u>calendar days</u> from the issue date of the IRCC refusal letter for your most recent application.
- If you request a refund for any other reason after getting your study permit in Canada, the refund request will be subjective to jurisdictional regulations and may need additional documents and evidence.



Your Bursary

By paying your fee deposit and international fee, you are eligible for a maximum of \$15,000 bursary, which will be applied to your tuition account in the following manner. The bursary values assume you will study 12 credits (4 courses) a term and will complete 36 credits (12 courses) in your first three terms. In the event that a full 4-course term is not studied each of the first three terms, there will be a true-up in the final term of study to ensure that the student receives a full \$10,000 bursary over 120 credits. As you are transferring from another Canadian institution, you may be eligible for the YU Onshore Transfer Students Bursary (valued at \$5,000, will be applied to your account as payment towards your final term). For all students, the university reserves the right to change the weighting and payment timing of the \$15,000 bursary.
