If the international application is open for a country, then PALs are available; however, country caps may be reached before an offer is accepted and the tuition deposit is received. Important information to consider before you Accept Your Offer:

Securing housing before arriving in Cape Breton plays a vital role in your student experience. Like most of Canada, affordable housing is a serious issue in Cape Breton. Housing in the area is limited and students should begin their search early.

We recommend living on-campus for your first year of study. To view residence options, visit cbu.ca/residence. If you're interested in living off-campus, housing listings can be found at cbu.ca/accommodations.

We strongly advise students to budget their costs and expenses accordingly for when you arrive in Cape Breton. We recommend budgeting a minimum of \$1,000 per month for housing and other related expenses.

Part-time employment opportunities in Cape Breton are limited and very competitive. Employment cannot be guaranteed by CBU.

- The tuition deposit is non-refundable/non-transferable (with the exception of denied visa, or if the applicant is deemed ineligible for a PAL).
