✓ Accept Your Offer through Your Application Portal

✓ Pay Your Tuition Deposit

- Undergraduate international students on a study permit are required to pay a \$1,000.00 tuition deposit upon acceptance of admission.
- Class registration cannot proceed for new students until payment of the deposit is received.
- The deposit may be transferred between terms for the period the admission offer is valid.
- 100% of the tuition deposit is applied toward tuition and fees.
- Pay your tuition deposit through your student portal by Credit Card or Flywire.
- The tuition deposit is non-refundable unless your study permit application is denied, in which case you can request a partial refund of your tuition deposit in the amount of \$500.00. Please email refund requests to international.admissions@uregina.ca.

✓ Provincial Attestation Letter

• Students are required to have a <u>Provincial Attestation Letter</u> (PAL) before applying for a study permit. Once you are fully accepted, and have replied to your offer and paid your tuition deposit, you will be eligible for the U of R to request your PAL from the Government of Saskatchewan. The province will then issue your PAL through the MyCreds platform. After you have paid your tuition deposit, ensure that you login, and have access to, your <u>uregina email account</u>. You will be notified by email to your uregina email account when your PAL is available to download from MyCreds.

✓ Apply for Your Study Permit

- Once you receive your Attestation Letter, you can apply for your study permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). It is recommended to apply for a study permit well in advance of your intended start date.
- For more information about applying for a study permit, please visit the IRCC website here.
- You will be issued your study permit by a border officer when you enter Canada. You are required to submit a copy of your study permit
 and student visa to UR International after you arrive.

Scholarship Terms and Conditions

- If you were conditionally admitted to the University of Regina, your final grades must continue to meet our admission requirements and meet the minimum requirements for the International Student of Distinction scholarship.
- This scholarship is renewable each year for up to three years (3.5 years for the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science). The conditions of renewal are as follows:

First-Year Students

- -Complete a minimum of 30 credit hours per 12-month cycle from the semester you begin.
- -Of the 30 credit hours completed, at least 24 credit hours must have a UGPA of 80%.
- -Achieve a minimum UGPA of 75%.

Second-Year and Third-Year Students

- -Complete a minimum of 30-credit hours in each academic year.
- -Achieve a minimum UGPA of 80%.
- If you do not complete 30 credit hours per 12-month cycle, the scholarship will be permanently rescinded, at which time you will become responsible for future housing costs.
- If your UGPA drops below 80%, the scholarship will be rescinded, at which time you will become responsible for future housing costs. If you raise your UGPA above 80%, and you have met the credit hour requirement per 12-month cycle, the scholarship will be reinstated the following term.
- You will be required to participate in recruitment initiatives and agree to be featured in the University of Regina's international recruitment
 promotional campaigns.
- Non-academic and academic misconduct may result in loss of scholarship.
- You will not receive the scholarship during Co-op work term(s) and/or official U of R semester-based exchange programs.
- Recipients of this scholarship are not eligible for other scholarships funded by the University of Regina.

As a recipient of this scholarship, it is your responsibility to ensure you meet the eligibility to renew the scholarship in future semesters. Please ensure you save a copy of these terms and conditions for your reference. The Scholarship & Program Coordinator will arrange a meeting to review these conditions and support you in implementing a plan to successfully remain eligible for the scholarship.
