- have adequate financial resources to pay tuition fees and support their stay in Canada; and
- do not belong in a category of persons inadmissible to Canada under the Act.


Based on careful review of the information contained in your application and all of the documentation you have provided in support of your application, I have concluded that you do not meet the requirements of the Act and Regulations.

You must leave Canada on or before the expiry of your current document or, if your document has expired you must leave Canada immediately. Failure to do so could result in enforcement action being taken against you.

PLEASE NOTE: As per R222(1) A study permit becomes invalid upon the first to occur of the following days:

- (a) the day that is 90 days after the day on which the permit holder completes their studies.
- (a.1) the day on which the permit holder is no longer enrolled at the designated learning institution that is named in the permit, other than as a result of completing their studies;
- **(b)** the day on which the study permit is cancelled under section 222.7, 222.8 or 243.2; or
- (c) the day on which the permit expires.
